Directions

We will do this in four 5 minute rounds.

You will have one partner for the first 2 rounds and a different partner for the second 2 rounds.

Do the following for Rounds 1 & 2; then select a new partner and repeat for Rounds 3 & 4

1. Choose a Partner
2. Sit facing each other; one person should have their back to the screen
3. The partner facing the screen will see a word and photo and must try to describe it
4. The partner with their back to screen will attempt to draw what is being described
(have paper, pen/pencil ready)
5. The drawing partner may ask questions
6. When time is called, partners will switch positions and repeat

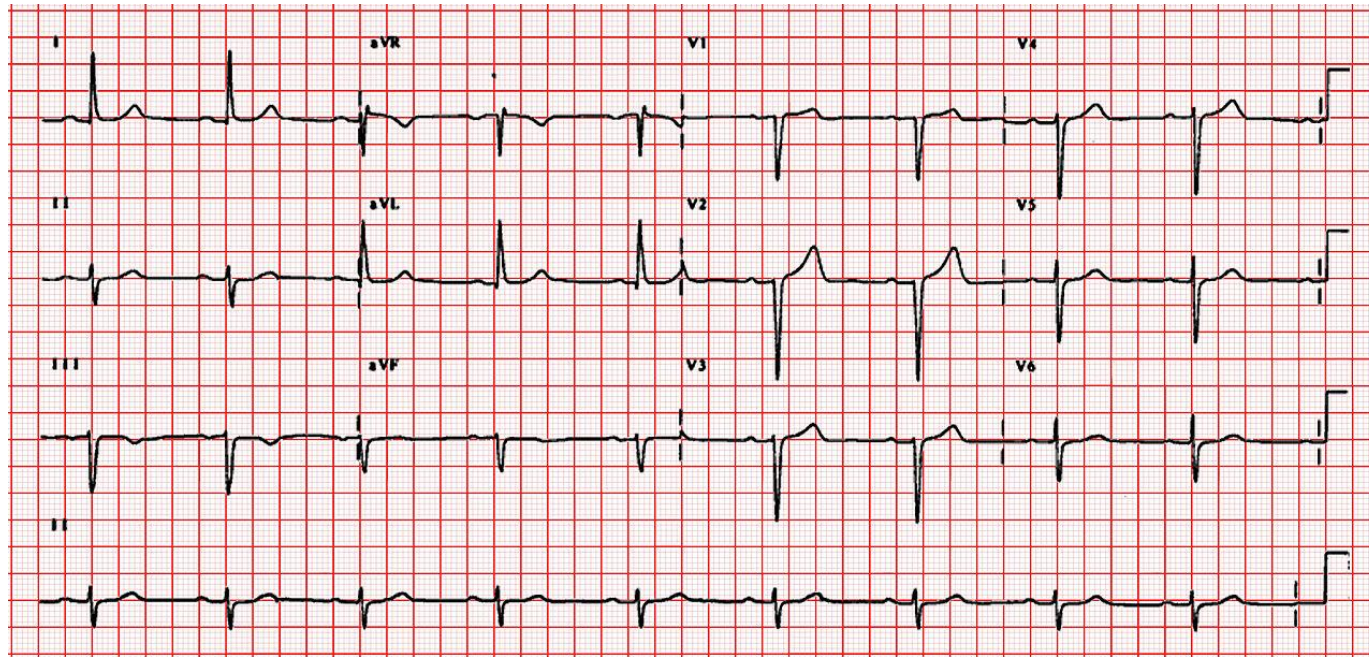
Chicken Pox; Varicella Zoster-Virus Infection
