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

### **ECMO**

- Used when other treatments have failed
- Blood removed from the body, oxygen added, and carbon dioxide removed, then pumped back into the body
- CM is a high-volume, highsuccess ECMO center since 1987



### **Diaries as Interventions**

- Used in Europe successfully since 1980's
- Beginning to be used in adult ICUs in US to decrease anxiety, depression, and PTSD
- Fills memory gaps, engages staff, increased trust between staff and family

### **Post Intensive Care Syndrome**

- Long-lasting mental, cognitive, and physical symptoms after extended ICU stay
- 80% of PICU survivors report PICS symptoms
- Pediatric ECMO survivors at highest risk





### **Next Steps**

- Customized bedside diaries with non-digital picture options for ECMO patients
- Consulted legal team and Family Advisory Board
- Education for ECMO team and ICUs done
